He is out of the Jate Lobell mare Miami Spice 3, 1:54.4/5, the dam of five winners from seven foals with three in 2:00 and a half-sister to the multiple Stakes winner Tattler's Torpedo 1:53.4/5 (\$400,737), Life Is A Cabaret 1:50.2/5 (\$865,280) the Hayes Memorial winner Mr. Tuff Guy 1:54.4/5 (\$109,825) and Black Tattler 1:50 (\$173,101).

Major In Art, now a three year old, has the credentials to become a world class sire. Commercial breeders must include this sensational son of Art Major in their breeding programmes this season.
